Wastewater General Safety: Tom Ratermann reviewed the Emergency Procedures After a Sewer Backup policy, adopted in 2008. Fliers with the policy were passed out, to be stored in trucks. Ratermann stated that if in doubt, office staff should always send out a service call. Crew should immediately respond, determine where the blockage is, and use the preventative maintenance program. It is important that the crew issue no statements of blame while providing service, and instruct customers to call the office with questions.

Ratermann stated that the first thing that happens when a potential claim is recognized is notifying the insurance company. The insurance company will determine liability for each claim. The next day crew goes out to televise the line where the backup occurred. The policy authorizes Ratermann to spend up to \$6,000 to assist homeowners in cleanup, and will recommend ServePro or ServiceMaster.

Equipment Safety: Summertime PPE will be reviewed at the next meeting. Sandi Clark cautioned that all crew should have sunblock, bug wipes, and an EpiPen if necessary. It was requested that ant and wasp killer be stocked and on-hand.

Many of the WWTP's have UV lights. Face shields have been issued for use during maintenance.

Accidents or Near Misses: There were no accidents or near misses.
