Dear Board of Trustees,

We have been examining methods for implementing our Cured in Place Pipe Program to rehabilitate lines within our system in order to minimize future root intrusion, water infiltration, and reduce the future maintenance burden for lines that are good candidates for this program. We have budgeted \$150,000 for FY2026 for this purpose.

We have determined, after working with the City of Columbia Purchasing Department, that Boone County Regional Sewer District is a member of the Mid-Missouri Public Purchasing Cooperative.

In 2025, the City of Columbia performed a public bid for a 5-year contract for Cured-In-Place-Pipe, which was awarded to Ace Pipe cleaning. The contract allows members of the Mid-Missouri Public Purchasing Cooperative to utilize the contract and work out specific agreements with Ace Pipe Cleaning based on this parent contract. We will be working with legal to have an agreement with Ace presented to you at the May meeting for consideration.

The first scope of work will be to rehabilitate the Highfield Acres collection system. We anticipate this scope of work will consume approximately half of our CIPP budget for FY2026. We will work out subsequent scope of work in Summer of 2026 for a fall 2026 lining scope with Ace, after the Highfield project is completed.
